



Ankylosing Spondylitis Victoria Inc 10th Anniversary 2005 -2015



Grants from Government bodies and Philanthropic organizations':


Our incorporated group becomes eligible for larger grants from a wider audience


Health Professionals and Services:




To reach users of modern social media we created a face book page. Many of our Associates also use fb and have been a great source of material to pass on to our members.




